SNORKELING | SELF GUIDED

Step into Exuma's turquoise waters and experience an underwater world like nothing you've seen before. Our islands and cays are home to some of the world's most beautiful coral reefs, and there are numerous snorkel spots just waiting to be explored.

Snorkeling Near Grand Isle

Stop by the Hummingbird Hut adjacent to the pool to pick up your complimentary snorkel gear, and then head to either of the great snorkel options adjacent to Grand Isle Resort & Spa

- Emerald Bay (beginner): Along the rocky shores bordering the golf course next to Grand Isle is not only a living coral reef but a unique eco-adventure experience. Swim through the shallow underwater snorkeling areas around the various reef formations and be amazed by all of the brightly coloured tropical fish and coral. This snorkeling area, accessible by walking into the water right from the resort beach, is perfect for those just learning to snorkel and beginning swimmers.
- Marina Beach and Poor Betty Cay (intermediate). Grab your snorkel gear, hop in your golf cart, and head over to Marina Beach; ask the Security Guards at the gate for directions. This little piece of snorkeling heaven often provides amazingly clear and bountiful snorkeling. The best spot for observing fish and coral is along the south-west edge of Poor Betty Cay, the small cay in the middle of the bay. Due to the water depth and distance you'll need to cross to get to the reefs at Poor Betty Cay, this snorkeling spot is best for intermediate and above swimmers.

Snorkeling Tours | Starfish Adventure Center

If you'd prefer a guided snorkeling experience, join the Starfish Adventure Center for an exciting tour of several outstanding snorkel locations in the Elizabeth Harbor area near George Town. During this excursion, a variety of tropical fish, coral reefs, starfish, barracudas, stingrays, dolphins, and even turtles may await your discovery.

All Starfish Adventure Center trips are small, intimate groups of 12 or fewer people, led by a trained guide. Or if you'd prefer to have the boat to yourself, book a private tour. Just let the Concierge know what you desire, and they'll be happy to confirm a tour for you.
